

3D Mining Complex Virtual Tour
Buggerru, Italy

SJM Tech produced a 3D virtual tour of two historical mining facilities in Buggerru, Italy. The interactive visualization was created using more than 1 terabyte of survey data from more than 200 laser-scanner stations located at the Porto Flavia and Galleria Henry mines. Available for viewing on the web, the simulations provided a high-fidelity representation of the structures as well as audio-visual content strategically positioned along the visitor's path.

MicroStation provided the platform for combining the complex survey data in optimized 3D textured models. SJM Tech's work involved aerophotogrammetry and digital cartography, 3D digital terrain model optimization, 3D mesh data manipulation, laser scanner point-cloud visualization, and 3D modeling and texturization. The final DGN file was exported to the client's CAD application.

The candidates for these awards were placed into nomination by the jurors for their uniquely innovative and visionary achievements embracing multiple *Be Inspired Awards* categories. The nominees were then reviewed by a panel of Bentley executives.
